 with everyone this year.

Meeting Dates:

New Business:

Halloween Dance

- Hallowe'en Dance is fast approaching Tuesday October 31! The total cost of the DJ was \$635.63. The \$200 deposit has already been paid and the remaining balance to be paid on day of. Alicia our Treasurer will prepare a cheque request for the remaining balance owing (\$435.63). Note the funds for this dance were already raised last school year and set aside.
- Volunteers for a sub-committee to help both for set up and during the dance are needed. Please let me know if you would like to help.
- Subcommittee to determine if this dance can be used as one of the school's minor fundraisers.
- For those new to council and parents joining this evening, our school is allowed to host TWO major fundraisers a year (such as the Chocolate Fundraiser we did last year) and several small fundraisers (such as the sale last year of glow kits at the Halloween Dance to help cover the cost of the DJ).

Principal's Report - L. Mundy

- It's wonderful to be back again at St. Dominic this school year. Staff were so excited to welcome students back to school.
- We have welcomed back many staff from previous years and have some new staff that have joined us. Two classroom teachers are on an LTO assignment for Ms. Marasco and Ms. Formica. We also have 3 student monitors that have joined us again from last year. We have 12 classrooms (including two FDK classes). FDK/FDK/ Gr 1, 1/2, 1/2, 2/3, 3/4, 4/5, 5/6, 5/6, 6/7, 7/8. We currently have enrolled 286 students.
- Two of our portables are in use. One is used for French, and one is used for planning time classes.
- We had an Earth Rangers presentation on September 21st, where the students got to see some beautiful animals, learn about their habits, and play some fun games. Thank you to Ms. Paterson for organizing this event.
- Ms. Frigo led a group of our intermediate students to a leadership conference to promote student well-being in the school.
- We have completed our Fire Drill requirement for the fall.
- Our Terry Fox Run was a huge success. Thank you to Ms. Rogowski, Ms. Seseri and Ms. Crevier for organizing. We raised a total of \$1559.00.
- Open house was a success. It was a great opportunity for families to come and meet their classroom teachers, visit classrooms, mingle with other families, and visit our donation book swap. Thank you to all the families supporting our food drive for Compass Food Bank. We will be collecting until this Friday. --Thank you to Ms. Muglia, Ms. Seseri and Ms. Frigo for organizing our Orange Shirt Day liturgy.

- We celebrated and promoted bike & roll week Oct 2-5th. Thank you to Ms. Paterson, the students and teacher volunteers.
- World Teacher's Day was on October 5th. Thank you to all of our teachers for your commitment to our students and for being faithful leaders to our school community.
